As this was the year of Pandemic, many schools denied as well due to constraints of online teaching and some new schools were also approached for the same and internship held in online mode only. We are permanent partners with sister institutions of our college and apart from this schools under Chief Khalsa Diwan Society, H.K Public School, Luv Dale Senior Secondary School, Madhav Vidya Niketan and other schools of repute in the city. Apart from this initially Punjab Government in collaboration with affiliating university, GNDU, Amritsar allocates government schools to the students, but this year only 37 students of B.Ed. were allocated schools, rest of the students were allocated private schools, for which list was shared with students and students gave their choices for the schools and maximum number of students got the schools of their choice. We have developed good relations with practicing schools, where schools are initially oriented with total internship.

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Title of the Activity: Workshop on Life Skills


Date and Venue: 2/12/2020, Little Flower School, Harsha Chinna

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### School Teachers as Evaluators in Skill in Teaching

As a part of joint efforts of teacher education institutes and schools, Khalsa College of Education, Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar, invites teachers of schools, as evaluators in final skill in teaching examination of B.Ed. and M. Ed. Integrated students every year. In present year, internship of batch (2019-21; 2019-22) was swapped from third to fourth semester which is in process. So in 6 months internship of batches 2018-20, 2018-21 of B.Ed. and B.Ed. M.Ed. Integrated respectively in 2019 odd term teachers of different subjects from Khalsa College International Public School, Ranjit avenue, Amritsar, Ajanta Public School, Basant Avenue were invited for evaluating final skill in teaching of students. College as a requirement of university Examination and to bring quality and transparency in final evaluation seeks facilitation from school teachers in evaluating performance of prospective teachers. Formal requirement for evaluators was send to the school principals before hand and consent of the principal was taken through letter or telephonically. On the days of exam teachers evaluated as well as gave constructive suggestions to our students. Finally, principal thanked all teachers from schools and the n principals over lunch on final day of exam for sparing their precious time for the college and also giving their valuable and experiences suggestions to our students.

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### Donation of Teaching Aids

Every year students of B.Ed, B.Ed-M.Ed Integrated prepare many teaching aids as a part of their practice in teaching. During their practice in schools they prepare supplementary aids for teaching different subjects and these aids are donated to school at the end of teaching practice in schools by the students in their respective schools, even students prepare variety of teaching learning resources during their discussion lessons and final skill in teaching which are submitted to the college at the end.
